Important:

- Age 3 years+

- The Scooter Board is intended for INDOOR USE only.
- The Scooter Board is suitable for HARD FLOORS only.

Good to know:

- Dimensions (including handles) – Width: 53cm; Length: 40.5cm; Weight: 1.5kg.
- Integrated contoured handles to help grip and aid stability and balance.
- Suitable for children to sit, kneel or lie on the Scooter Board.

Ten fun things to do with a Scooter Board:

- **Body bowling** - Set up bowling pins at one end of the room, and have the child ride the Scooter Board to knock them over.
- **Fishing** - Scatter magnetic fish around the floor and have the child go find them all.
- **Superman catch** – Get the child to lie on their tummy and propel themselves to catch or balance objects.
- **Rope pull** - Pull the child around with a rope or a hula hoop.
- **Complete a puzzle** - Have the puzzle pieces at one end of the room, and the puzzle board at the other end of the room.
- **Sorting** - Have bean bags or other objects at one end of the room that can be sorted into containers at the other end of the room.
- **Shopping** - Place play food around the room, tell them what they need to find and get.
- **Obstacle course** – Set up cones, pillows or other obstacles and get the child to scoot around them.

- **Balancing** - Place cones around the room and give the child ping pong balls that they must place on top of the cones.
- **Follow the path** - Create a path using masking tape on the floor and get the child to follow it – if you want to be more adventurous why not try creating a maze!

Care and maintenance:

- **Board maintenance** - Wipe clean with water and a soft cloth. Do not use corrosive cleaning agents (such as disinfectant, alcohol) to prevent material aging. Avoid exposure to sunlight and high-temperature environments to prevent deformation and cracking.
- **Wheel care** – Clean the wheels with a small brush to prevent debris from getting stuck in the bearings and affecting rotation. Avoid long-term sliding on rough surfaces to reduce wheel wear.
- **Inspection** – Regularly check the Scooter Board to ensure the wheel mountings are secure. If not, tighten as required, to prevent detachment.
- **Storage requirements** - When not in use, store the Scooter Board in a dry, well-ventilated area away from damp environments to prevent bearing rust and board mildew.
To keep the Scooter Board flat and even, do not stack heavy objects on the Scooter Board.
